Numbers declined and quality was very good across the new season grades, while the older lambs were a little mixed in presentation. There were mainly trade and heavyweights penned with 4,000 new season lambs offered. The light lambs were limited in number and all the buyers were present and operating. Competition was good resulting in a firm to slightly dearer market.

Medium and heavy trade weight new season lambs were firm and averaged around 515c/kg cwt. Most of the quality heavy trade weights sold from \$114 to \$118/head. Heavyweights made up the majority and were also firm to \$1 dearer and averaged 505c/kg cwt. A number of pens sold from \$125 to \$128/head.

Trade weight old lambs were around firm and averaged 455c/kg cwt. While heavyweights were \$1 to \$6/head cheaper and averaged from 456c to 466c/kg cwt. The odd pen of extra heavy lambs sold from \$137 to \$140/head.

Mutton was limited in supply and quality was mixed. Heavy first cross ewes were up to \$8/head cheaper and averaged \$77.60/head or 256c/kg cwt. Medium wethers averaged \$64.20/head or 284c/kg cwt.
