There were similar numbers of lambs and mutton at Powranna and Killafaddy with very few heavy and extra heavy lambs included. The larger numbers of light lambs met strong restocker and export competition to average \$5 to \$10 dearer, while the few top quality trade and heavy lambs were \$5 to \$8/head cheaper.

Light export lambs sold for \$59 to \$90, while restockers paid \$70 to \$104/head with a definite preference for recently shorn pens. Light trade lambs made \$90 to \$106, while trade weights made from \$102 to \$120 and the few heavy pens sold from \$117 to \$141/head.

Most mutton averages were \$5 to \$10/head cheaper after last week's very strong sale. Light sheep made \$23 to \$51, while light weights sold from \$49 to \$65 and medium weights sold from \$65 to \$76/head. The few heavy sheep made from \$74 to \$89/head.
