

## **Detailed saleyard report - sheep and lamb**

Numbers declined significantly on the back of last week's cheaper trend. Old trade lambs were in reasonable supply, along with an excellent selection of approximately 6,850 new season lambs. Extra heavy lambs were in limited numbers and not all export buyers operated fully. A full turnout of domestic and export buyers were in attendance, however not all major export companies operated fully. There was limited competition from restockers and lot feeders and they paid from \$89.20 to \$115/head for well-bred new season lambs.

The reduction in numbers of old trade lambs led to stronger demand, with all buyers keen to capture the better finished, shorter skinned lamb. The better shaped trade lambs (22-24kg) made from \$128 to \$138/head to average 533c/kg cwt. New season trade lamb numbers lifted and there were more buyers operating. Bidding was strongest for medium and heavy trade categories with prices \$7 to \$8/head dearer. Medium and heavy lambs made from \$128 to \$140, to average 551c/kg cwt, with buyers operating on skin values of \$6 to \$9/head. Light weight 1 and 2 score lambs suitable for the processors were very limited, with only a few agents offering this category, and they made from \$65 to \$80/head. The better finished Merino lambs suitable for the trade sold to a small group of buyers and ranged from of \$74 to \$116/head. There was a mixed selection of heavy and extra heavy lambs offered to a small group of buyers. Lambs weighing 24 and 26kg sold a few dollars dearer, while extra heavy lambs lifted \$4 to \$9/head to average 506c/kg cwt. Well finished extra heavy lambs made from \$144 to \$174/head.

Mutton numbers declined moderately in a mixed quality yarding, with all weights and grades represented. The greater numbers of ewes and wethers were medium and heavy weights, with a significant portion shorn. Merino ewe mutton sold to steady demand, with prices generally unchanged to \$3/head dearer. Crossbred ewes were not as keenly contested, with prices easing slightly and the heavy grades averaging 279c/kg cwt. Merino wethers were well supplied, with most pens carrying increased weight compared to other sales. Heavy wethers to slaughter made from \$90 to \$114.20, while a single pen of wethers with an estimated carcass weight of 35kg reached a top price of \$120/head. Light weight sheep were eagerly sought after and sold \$5 to \$8/head dearer, averaging 286c to 335c/kg cwt. There was also an order in place for wethers to turnout and they sold from \$75 to \$86.20/head.
