

## Detailed saleyard report - sheep and lamb

Quality was mixed in what was a typical wintery offering of lambs. There were high percentages of trade and heavy weights penned, as quality ranged from prime to the longer wool dryer lambs. There were a couple of extra pens of new season lambs and the usual buyers competed in a dearer market.

New season lambs sold well, as the trade weights ranged from \$108 to \$122 and up to \$147/head for the heavier drafts. These categories attained an average price from 530c to 562c/kg cwt.

The older trade weights gained \$8, as the 20kg to 24kg weight ranges sold from \$92 to \$128/head. The heavier end reached \$146, also a lift of \$7/head. The better finished lambs averaged around the 473c to 500c/kg cwt.

A small penning of mutton was offered, with the lower numbers contributing to price increases. The medium and heavy weights sold from \$58 to \$100/head, as the better 2 to 4 score sheep averaged from 305c to 340c/kg cwt.
