

## Detailed saleyard report - sheep and lamb

It was a pretty good quality yarding of lambs with a good selection of trade and heavy weight new season lambs throughout. Old lambs and Merinos were in limited supply.

Lightweight lambs were \$5 dearer with 12kg to 18kg 2 score new season lambs selling from \$58 to \$91/head. Trade weight lambs were \$3 to \$4 cheaper, with new season lambs selling from \$82 to \$113/head to average 474c/kg cwt. Heavy weight lambs were \$4 to \$6 cheaper with over 22kg new season lambs selling from \$117 to \$128, while heavy weight old lambs sold to \$130/head. Restockers paid to \$98 and hoggets sold to \$86/head.

It was a mixed yarding of mutton with some very heavy crossbred sheep yarded along with some good lines of Merino wethers. There was also a fair percentage of plainer sheep penned. Ewes were \$12 to \$15 cheaper, while wethers were \$7/head easier. The 2 score ewes sold from \$37 to \$54 while the 3 and 4 scores sold from \$50 to \$77 for Merinos and \$80/head for crossbreds. The 3 and 4 score Merino wethers sold from \$52 to \$84/head.
