Overall numbers remained steady with an increase in lambs and a reduction in consignments of sheep. The quality of the lambs was fair to good. There were fair supplies of young lambs, Merino and trade weight old lambs. Heavy old lambs were also in fair numbers, however there were none of the extra heavy weights this week. The usual buyers were in operation.

Despite some decent rainfalls over a wide area there was little change in market trends for the young lambs. Well finished trade weight old lambs and the better Merino lambs also experienced little change. Heavy old lambs sold to a slightly cheaper trend. Overall numbers in the system contributed to negating much of the price benefit normally associated with such a rain event.

There was strong demand for grown sheep, resulting in a dearer market trend. The best of the medium and heavy sheep improved by as much as \$10/head.
