

## Detailed saleyard report - sheep and lamb

With Sheepvention in Hamilton this week, only a token offering of sheep and lambs were offered to just a handful of the usual buyers. Lamb quality was plain to average and comprised mostly of light to medium weights with sheep, mainly wethers, of good quality. Because of the small numbers penned and buyers not being able to fill a truck, the reduced competition resulted in prices being lowered further. Light weight lambs were \$10 cheaper, while trade and heavy weight lambs were \$15 to \$20 lower and sheep sold mainly \$5 to \$8/head easier.

The light weight 2 score lambs made \$40 to \$55, while light trade weight 2 and 3 scores were from \$57 to \$70/head. Medium to heavy weight 3 score trade lambs sold between \$62 and \$82/head and averaged 365c/kg cwt. The heavy weight 4 score lambs made \$80 to \$84/head and averaged 340c/kg cwt.

A run of 2 and 3 score wether sheep averaged 310c/kg cwt. Most medium to heavy weight sheep sold between \$70 and \$90/head.
