There was an increased yarding of lambs, consisting of a good supply of trade weights, a fair penning of heavy weights, while there were several lots of light weight and increased numbers of Merino lambs. Quality was fairly good, although some lambs showed some signs of dryness. The market was much easier, with most lambs selling \$10 to \$15/head cheaper.

The yarding of mutton consisted mainly of medium weight sheep, along with few pens of heavy weights and light sheep. The sheep market was not affected to same extent as the lambs, with little movement in prices.
