Numbers increased, consisting of a larger percentage of trade and heavy weight lambs, with most well finished 3 scores. The market was not as strong as the sale two weeks ago, although prices held up reasonably well. Trade weight lambs ranged in price from \$89 to \$122, while heavy lambs sold from \$114 to \$145/head. Extra heavy weight lambs topped at \$161.50/head.

The yarding of mutton consisted of a good quality line up of both ewes and wethers, with several runs of heavy sheep throughout the sale. Ewes topped the market at \$78, while wethers sold to \$102.60/head.
