

Detailed saleyard report - sheep and lamb

Numbers rose as agents yarded 4,657 lambs and 487 sheep to total 5,144 head. Some good quality shorn lambs were offered as lambs broke the \$200/head mark. The usual trade and processor buyers were present along with a small restocker presence as prices generally were firm across the market.

Restockers purchased only a small number of lambs mainly from \$31 to \$95/head. Lightweight lambs ranged from \$77 to \$99 with lightweight trade 2 and 3 scores selling from \$105 to \$115/head. Trade weight 3 score lambs ranged from \$111 to \$136/head at an average of 570c/kg cwt. All of these lambs were firm in price. Heavy 4 score lambs ranged from \$130 to \$164/head also at an average of 570c/kg cwt. Heavy export 4 and 5 score lambs returned vendors from \$153 to a market high of \$206/head. The heavy lambs were \$4 to \$6/head dearer then last week.

The few hoggets sold from \$65 to \$110/head. Only a small number of sheep came forward and lightweight ewes ranged from \$44 to \$50/head. Medium weight 2 and 3 scores ranged from \$55 to \$91 with the heavier types returning vendors from \$99 to \$125, while rams made up to \$50/head.
