

## Detailed saleyard report - sheep and lamb

A smaller, good quality yarding of 6,351 crossbred lambs sold amid strong bidding from the usual array of trade and processor buyers. Restockers bid frequently, but failed to secure any significant numbers.

The few light weight lambs purchased by restockers sold from \$57 to \$79, while light weight 3 score lambs to trade buyers lifted \$9 selling from \$94 to \$103/head to average 467c/kg cwt. Light trade weight 4 score lambs lifted up to \$13 selling from \$101 to \$115 and averaged 477c, while heavy trade weights lifted \$8 selling from \$106 to \$125/head, to average 457c/kg cwt. Heavy weights lifted \$8 to \$11, they sold from \$122 to a high of \$140/head and returned 457c to 461c/kg cwt.

Hoggets sold from \$64 to \$80/head. A large selection of heavy weight ewes remained unchanged, selling from \$68 to \$87 and most rams returned \$10 to \$20/head.
