A very small, generally mixed yarding of 608 crossbred lambs sold to weaker demand. Buyer representation was down due to the numbers yarded.

Restockers had little influence, paying from \$33 to \$90, while light weight lambs to trade buyers eased \$13 to sell from \$72 to \$86/head. Light trade weights eased marginally, making from \$100 to \$114 and averaging 485c, while the few heavy weights sold from \$118 to \$126/head and returned 494c to 504c/kg cwt.

Hoggets sold from \$64 to \$82, while ewes returned \$64 to \$82 and rams sold at \$33/head.
