Detailed saleyard report - sheep and lamb

There was a much smaller number of both lambs and mutton at Powranna and Killafaddy which is usual for this time of the year. Mutton supplies are usually tight in early spring, while old lamb numbers tighten and it is still some time away until young lambs become prevalent. The lamb market averaged \$5 to \$15/head cheaper with less wholesale competition and also following the recent interstate trends.

Light Merino lambs destined for the Middle East sold from \$52 to \$62, while restockers bought British bred lambs for \$69 to \$79/head. Light trade lambs sold for \$74 to \$81, while trade weights made from \$90 to \$121 and the few heavy pens made from \$115 to \$130/head. The first pen of new season lambs sold for \$131/head.

The small numbers of mutton still attracted good competition without reaching the high averages of last week. Light ewes made \$44 to \$59, while medium weights sold from \$59 to \$74 and heavy ewes made from \$80 to \$81/head.
