Detailed saleyard report - sheep and lamb

There was another small penning of prime young lambs at Powranna and Killafaddy on Tuesday with many lighter store lambs included. Most prices were \$3 to \$7/head cheaper with store lambs firm. There were few old lambs but they sold to strong wholesale competition making \$81 to \$108/head.

Restockers paid \$53 to \$60 for very light lambs and \$70 to \$96/head for light lambs with most going to the northwest coast. Light trade lambs bought by the trade made \$93 to \$98, trade weights sold from \$92 to \$114, while heavy weights made from \$114 to \$118/head. The few extra heavy pens made from \$116 to \$128/head. The few old lambs made \$81 to \$108/head.

Most of the mutton yarding was made up of very heavy crossbred ewes and as result most prices averaged cheaper. Light ewes made \$39 to \$41, while medium weight sold from \$47 to \$50 and heavy weights made from \$52 to \$64/head. Restockers paid \$69 to \$70/head for crossbred ewes.
