Detailed saleyard report - sheep and lamb

There were slightly more lamb and sheep numbers this week at Powranna and Killafaddy, with the highlight being an outstanding run of store new season lambs that sold to very strong competition.

The quality of young lambs was very good with more heavy lambs available and most were \$3 to \$6/head dearer. Exporters bought light lambs for \$69 to \$78, while restockers paid \$75 to \$90/head, with most going to the northwest coast. Trade lambs made \$92 to \$118, while heavy weights sold from \$117 to \$120 and extra heavy weights made from \$120 to \$131/head.

Old lambs also sold to strong competition and made between \$89 and \$109/head.

Mutton prices improved \$4 to \$10/head on last week's lower trends with an extra Victorian order and strong local competition. Light sheep made \$40 to \$51, while medium weights sold from \$48 to \$60 and heavy ewes made from \$61 to \$78/head.
