There were small numbers of both lambs and mutton at Powranna and Killafaddy as the old lamb season comes to an end. With one major exporter absent it was left to local wholesalers to buy most of the lambs at prices similar to last week's lower rates. Two Victorian exporters pushed mutton prices higher with the exception of over condition sheep which were hard to sell.

Exporters bought light lambs for \$54 to \$61 while restockers were selective in the \$66 to \$74/head range. Light trade lambs averaged \$8 cheaper and sold for \$69 to \$81, while trade lambs made \$73 to \$117 and heavy pens made from \$100 to \$110/head. Quality was mixed and this caused a wide range of prices in some weight ranges.

Most mutton prices were firm with very light sheep making \$22 to \$44, light ewes and wethers \$38 to \$51, medium weights \$45 to \$78/head. A few heavy sheep made \$50 to \$81/head.
