There was a slight increase in both lamb and sheep numbers, although overall it remained another small and mixed winter yarding. Quality was plain to average at best. The lamb offering comprised mainly of smaller pen lots of mixed breeding, and there was no stand-out export or trade weight lambs to really test buyer demand. Prices were cheaper when compared to the previous sale, but were in line with the reduced rates recorded at most southern markets held in the past week.

Most of the trade weight lambs sold from \$113 to a top of \$144/head and ranged from an estimated 520c to 565c/kg cwt. Lighter lambs sold to slaughter generally made from \$88 to \$102, with some very light and plain pens from \$53 to \$66/head. There was four pens of early drop new season lambs in the yarding which sold from \$115 to \$135 to average around 550c/kg cwt based on a skin return of \$5 to \$6/head.

The sheep sale was very mixed and limited. The better slaughter ewes sold from \$75 to \$95, and handful of wethers to \$110/head. Mutton prices did fluctuate but the overall average was estimated at 320c to 340c/kg cwt, with odd sales higher.
