There was a slight reduction in both sheep and lamb offerings. Quality through the lambs was generally good with well finished trade and heavyweights well supplied. There was a limited selection of good quality lightweights. All buyers from the previous sale were in attendance.

There was little change in market trends through all weight classes. Some price changes were evident, however much of that was brought about by variations in quality.

The overall quality of the sheep offering was below previous weeks and this was reflected in price changes on an otherwise close to firm market trend.
